This month was a month of networking as we look to get plugged into the Dayton Hispanic community. A member of Cornerstone Baptist who is also a police officer for the city of Dayton invited me to an event for the Hispanic community. I was able to meet the president of the Dayton Hispanic Chamber of Commerce as well as the Spanish-speaking liaison for "Welcome Dayton". As a family we were able to attend Dayton's Hispanic Heritage Festival and give out information about the Bible study. It was exciting to meet some fellow Peruvians also! We need your prayers as we seek to gather a core group of people to disciple and train for the future church. Pray for people to come, pray for their salvation, pray for willing hearts to learn God's Word, and pray for co-laborers who speak Spanish to team up with us.

Peru: Thank you once again for your prayers and support for Faith Baptist's building project in Cusco. A year ago we broke ground and the foundation was laid. This past month the people were able to meet in the building for services. Praise the Lord! Little by little, as God provides, the people will have to do the finishing work. Being in the building has allowed Pastor Paul to start the youth group up again and the regular Saturday Kid's Club. They are already reaping the benefits of having their own space.
