The event went great and allowed us to meet several key people involved with the organization as well as get to know more of the Hispanic community in Dayton.

Fairfield: We have been very encouraged in the Spanish ministry at BBC. The core group is faithfully attending and several who are infrequent visitors came multiple Sundays. When working with hispanics numbers fluctuate greatly from week to week depending on work and other activities. We try to focus on engagement and spiritual growth and we are slowly seeing progress in those areas. This month a couple of the families had difficulties and family emergencies but remained faithful in spite of them. We thank the Lord for this. Please continue to pray for the salvation of several people who are attending faithfully. Pray for future leadership for this ministry as well.

Peru: Faith Baptist in Cusco was able to minister to children and families in their community this month. They held a traditional “Chocolatada” (panettone and hot chocolate party). Pastor Paul reports that it was a great time. We continue to help the ministry in Peru as we can which means you had a part in ministering to these children and their parents. Thank you!
